

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY  
AND  
ARGONNE NATIONAL LABORATORY  
FOR  
HEALTH SERVICES

1. **PURPOSE** The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to set forth understandings between the Argonne National Laboratory (ANL) and the Department of Energy (DOE) for the health services that are being provided to Federal employees by the ANL Medical Department (ANL-MD) at the Argonne site. This MOU is not intended to create legally binding obligations. Rather, the MOU is intended to describe a cooperative working agreement between ANL and the DOE offices located at the ANL site which include the Ames Site Office (AMSO), Argonne Site Office (ASO), Chicago Office (CH), Office of Counterintelligence (OCI) and Office of Inspector General (OIG).
  
2. **BACKGROUND** The DOE Federal Employee Health Services Program is established for the purpose of helping to provide for the safety and health of DOE employees through the provision of medical and other health related services by qualified personnel who possess appropriate certification and training. The scope and nature of medical services rendered are predicated in part on the analysis of existing or potential health hazards to which employees may be exposed as well as specific job tasks. This is accomplished through close cooperation with professionals in environment, safety and health, industrial hygiene, health physics, human resources, and management.
  
3. **REQUIREMENTS** Requirements and guidance for DOE Federal employee health services programs are found in DOE O 341.1 Federal Employee Health Services, O 440.1A Worker Protection Management for DOE Federal and Contractor Employees, G 341.1-1 Guide on Federal Employee Occupational Medical Programs, and G 440.1-4 Contractor Occupational Medical Program Guide For Use With DOE Order 440.1.
  
4. **SCOPE OF SERVICES** Health services will be provided by ANL-MD under the direction of a licensed physician and licensed professional nurses. ANL-MD will provide the following services for DOE employees covered by this MOU:
  - Diagnosis, stabilization, treatment, or reference of onsite injuries and illnesses.
  
  - Medical facilities equipped to meet requirements of the occupational medical program.
